ScholarMade Achievement Place of Arkansas, a public charter system was comprised three connected schools serving grades K-9 during the 2022-2023 school year. ScholarMade is a Community Eligibility Provision system serving free meals to 100% of the population. Caucasian: 2.20%; African American: 92.67%; Hispanic: 2.56%; 2 or more races: 2.56%. The Annual Budget is based on 380 students.

## ANNUAL PUBLIC MEETINGS

ScholarMade Achievement Place of Arkansas held public meetings on August 9 and August 10, 2023 to review and discuss SAPA Annual Report. The report contained outlining of goals and strategies key components of the model that will address any deficiencies. In addition to the public meetings, ScholarMade is publishing the report as part of its effort to constantly improve communication with parents, students, and community members. ## ACADEMIC GOALS

In our first year of operation, 83% of our Scholars scored in the Need Support category in reading. In 2021, that percentage of students was reduced to 62%. 21% of those students grew to the next performance level. Ivy Hill was one of 125 schools [12%] in the State that achieved growth from 2018 vs 2021. In 2022, 33% of Ivy Hill students scored proficient in math and increases of 13%. 19% scored ready in science an increase of 9%; and 18% scored ready in reading an increase of 4%. Nichols Intermediate achievement data reflected 13% ready in math; 15% ready in science; and 13% ready in reading. Prodigy Prep achievement data reflected 3% ready in math; 19% ready in ELA; 9% ready in science and 19% ready in reading.
